CAFOD Fast Day



On Friday 7th October it is CAFOD Fast Day. Every year we do something to raise money for children and families overseas. This Friday, we will have a mufti day. Everyone is invited to wear bright colours and donate £1 or whatever they can. We will send this money to support with building communities and resources overseas for those living in poverty.

URGENT PARKING REMINDER

Please can we ask all our parents to park sensibly and safely when collecting and dropping off their children. Parking illegally can be very dangerous for our community when trying to cross the road. Please keep the pavement clear.

Please do not park on the yellow hazards at any time. You will be asked to move and you risk a £70.00 instant fine if it is reported.

The hazards are there to ensure children can see clearly to cross the road and to give space either side of the crossing. However much of a hurry you are in, stopping and dropping on the hazard area or in the middle of the road puts your children's lives at risk and we have an obligation to report repeat offenders. Please park and walk your child into the playground and wait until their adult is present. We are responsible for your children from 8:45am. If you find getting children in and then getting to work in the morning tricky, then our Breakfast Club runs from 7:30am daily. Speak to Miss Rlley or the office about accessing this if it would help.
