In this week's Gospel Jesus tells the story of a widow who wanted justice and asked for help from a judge.

In Jesus' time, women weren't protected or supported as they are now. They did not have the same rights. Thankfully this is very different today but for the woman in the story, being a widow meant she had no source of income and no power or means to help herself.

Initially the judge ignored the widow but she refused to give up and persisted until he heard her case. Eventually the judge gave in and helped her as he should have done in the first place.

The message here is to be persistent and not to give up. Jesus teaches us that God is always there listening to our prayers. He is listening even when we are wondering if He has heard us. Sometimes the answer may not be obviou to us but God always has what is best for us at heart. Jesus teaches us never to give up on God as God will never give up on us.
