Grow Strong!

In this Gospel, Jesus teaches his disciples through a parable. A parable is a story which has a lesson in it for the listener. This parable was about a farmer who sowed seeds. Some seeds landed in rich soil and flourished; some seeds landed in dry and rocky ground and didn't grow.

Jesus says the seeds are like his message of love. Some seeds land in places where they do not do well. Some land on rock and can't take root. People can hear what Jesus says but don't let what he says make a difference in their lives.

Some people hear Jesus' message but they let other things, like money, take over. However, some seed lands on good soil. This seed can grow really well and produce a good harvest.

Jesus teaches us to be like the good soil receiving the seed; to let love grow and to cultivate the best within us. Jesus teaches that we can be like good soil if we listen to him and love one another.

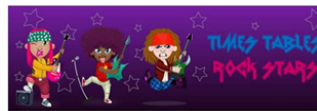
