Integrity: Daniel showed his excellent knowledge of animal adaptations in our science lesson this week.

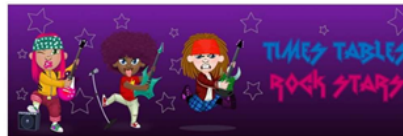
Justice: Eliza has worked so hard on her confidence and application of knowledge in her revision this week - you should be so proud of what you have achieved!

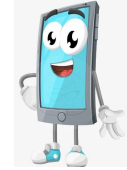

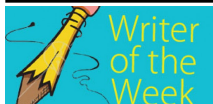
