The theme for Science week this year was 'connections'. To put our connections as s school to the test, we have spent the week passing a secret message from EYFS

through each class all the way up to Year 6. <u>Courage Class</u>

We made boats that could float on water and passed the message across our water trays to deliver it to Year 1 in the playground.

Kindness Class

We wrote the message in invisible wax, which is water resistant. Year 2 then revealed the message with coloured water!



<u>Compassion Class</u> We transferred our message around the room using a variety of materials, according to their properties, to carry the tin foil ball. We created a ramp, a bridge and collaborated to work as a team.



Peace Class

We passed the message all the way up the stairs in the KS2 building by using string telephones, which allowed our voices to travel as vibrations through the strings.

We looked at how we could use our knowledge of air resistance to construct paper aeroplanes that would be capable of delivering the message right into the Year 6 classroom.

We used our knowledge of electrical circuits to transmit an illuminating Morse Code message!

Integrity: Daniel has been a **Persevering Parrot** in English, taking advantage of tools and support to make fantastic progress in his writing.


Justice: Ethan T has been an **Exploring Elephant** in Maths, making sure he is reading all of the details of a question in order to answer it.
