Loved by God In this week's Gospel, we hear about the 'Transfiguration.' This is a moment in which Jesus is transformed before the disciples. It is one of the Luminous Mysteries of the Rosary, which reflect upon times when Jesus was illuminated or revealed to the world as God's son.

As Jesus and the disciples stand high on a mountain, Jesus is transfigured, "His face shone like the sun, and his clothes became as white as the light. Just then there appeared before them Moses and Elijah, talking with Jesus."

While he was still speaking, a bright cloud covered them, and a voice from the cloud said, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased. Listen to him!"

The disciples were overawed and frightened but Jesus reached out to them and reassured them not to be afraid. <u>Faith in Action</u> We can all listen to Jesus, just as God the Father asks us to. We hear Jesus' words when we listen to stories in the Bible. Jesus speaks to each of us deep in our hearts. We can practise listening to Jesus when we sit quietly and pray. 
