It has been lovely to reunite our school family this week, even with the darker nights and blustery days! This is a busy and hard working term and the children have settled right back into their learning. We've been proud of their achievements this week.

All Saints Mass

We began our week planting seeds and making transformational promises that we would be the best we can be. These will be displayed on our Values tree in the hall.

We had a wonderful Mass with the Parish and parents to mark All Saints day and the children's singing was beautiful.

Year 6 Art Project

This week, Year 6 have been taking part in the British Art Show Artists in Schools project, visiting both The Box and the KARST Gallery to explore themes of migration, healing and change.





The children behaved amazingly, shared their thoughts and ideas creatively and had a go at creating art in a range of ways. We're really looking forward to the final day of the project next week!

Attendance

Attendance has come into sharper focus this term and I have met with our Educational Welfare Officer. It is important you read and understand the guidance below.

We cannot authorise holidays in term times. There is a national Government push to improve attendance and they are implementing penalty fines of £60 per parent per child. For a parent of 2 children or 2 parents of 1 child, this will be £120 that will then double after ten days of non-payment.

It is really important that you know this information before booking a holiday. We have a legal requirement to issue a warning after 2-3 days and a penalty warning after 4-5 days. If your child is absent for a holiday for 5 days or more, you risk a penalty fine and if a child is absent for 10 sessions in a 6-week period, then the EWO becomes involved and carries out home visits.

As teachers with families, we share your frustration with price hikes in holiday times as it affects us too. However, the issue lies with holiday companies, which we have no control over. Please think carefully before booking a holiday as there is now a very strict Government policy in place and a high risk of a fine because the focus is on getting children back into learning and any learning missed can have a significant impact on your child.
