Liturgy and Worship



Hope of Life

In this week's Gospel, we hear the story of Lazarus, which foreshadows Jesus' own resurrection.

Jesus is called to Bethany, which is a place, by his good friends Martha and Mary. They have asked Jesus to come quickly as their brother, Lazarus, is very unwell.

By the time Jesus arrives in Bethany, his friend Lazarus has died. Jesus is very sad and cries because he loves Lazarus so much. No one can understand why, when he has healed so many people, Jesus did not save Lazarus.

Then Jesus does something amazing. He shows that he even has power over death. Jesus calls to Lazarus to come out of the tomb where he is buried – and Lazarus appears, alive and well. This miracle points towards the resurrection and Jesus' power over life and death.

John's Gospel has a number of signs, or miracles, which show us important things about Jesus.

The miracle of bringing Lazarus back to life is the last sign before the greatest miracle of all when Jesus rises from the dead himself. Jesus' miracles help us all to believe, like Martha, that Jesus is our saviour who gives us life.

When we pray, Jesus listens. There is hope when we give all our troubles and worries to Jesus, because he hears us.

Take time to pray this week and give your worries to Jesus.

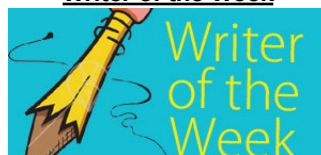
