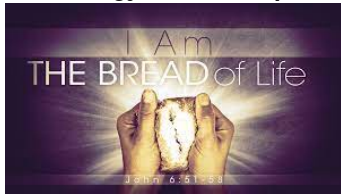

**Justice:** **Patrick C** has been a **Go For It Gorilla** this week, challenging himself in all of his learning, not just at school, but with his daily reading at home.



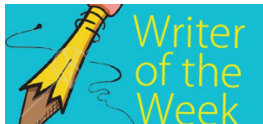
