Complete at least 1 soundcheck every day, aiming for 25/25 - how much can you improve in the summer term?</p>	<p>Create a paper prayer chain. Each week, add on a new link that says thank you, sorry, or asks for help with something that is on your mind. Is there a specific person, event, or place you would like to pray for? Use your Home Reading Diary for prayer ideas!</p>	<p>Science Create a sculpture using whatever materials you have at home to demonstrate the structure and functions of the human heart.</p>
<p>Write a diary entry from the point of view of someone in a country that is being invaded/taken over by the British Empire. It must be at least 200 words, or 1 page if handwritten.</p>	<p>Spend 10 minutes each week on Maths Flex to keep working along your pathway.</p>	<p>Design a poster to show what the Beatitudes mean in your own words, and how they can be shown in actions.</p>	<p>Geography Design and conduct a survey to find out how eco-friendly and sustainable your home is. What are you already doing at home to help the environment? What could you be doing better?</p>
<p>Read and perform a poem that is at least 8 lines long. Think carefully about expression and pace when you perform it to the class at the end of the Spring Term!</p>	<p>Design a Maths quiz or board game that we can have a go at on the last day of term. It must link to decimals or negative numbers!</p>	<p>Write a speech or letter explaining the importance of stewardship and encouraging others to be stewards of God's creation.</p>	<p>Art Create a piece of artwork, representing whatever subject you like, using what you have learned about pointilism.</p>
