Lord have mercy. LORD HAVE MERCY





Transformation

Our Gospel is the Wedding Feast at Cana, one of the luminous mysteries of the Rosary.

Jesus is revealed as having the power to transform the ordinary into the extraordinary.

As we listen to the reading, pay attention to the words, thoughts, images and feelings that come to your mind.

What is God saying to us in this Gospel?

What is His message to you?

A reading from the Gospel according to John Glory to you, O Lord



This is the Gospel of the Lord Praise to you Lord Jesus Christ

Time to reflect on God's words for us today.





In this Gospel, it is Jesus' mother who is the catalyst. Initially Jesus resists and tells Mary his time has not yet come but Mary's faith and belief in Jesus begins a chain of events that leads to Jesus' first miracle; a miracle of transformation

When Christ changes water into wine, he opens the door to faith, belief and its possibilities.

It is no accident that this miracle is echoed in The Last Supper.

Two thousand years later and it is again echoed every time we go to Mass where a transformation happens and Jesus is present in the bread and wine.



Take a moment to reflect upon the power of transformation.

Our chosen vocation means that transforming the lives of others gives us purpose and meaning.

Picture some of the children we are here for.

How can we help them to transform their lives?

What action can we take for the children we serve?





What do we want to transform in ourselves? Think about your work; Your home and family; Yourself;

What area of your life would you like to transform?
What conscious actions can you take towards this?



In a moment, collect a sunflower seed from the focal point.



Take it back to your seat and gently plant it in the soil.

Collect your seed and in the silence of your heart, spend a moment responding to God's call to transformation.
